



2019 NFL DRAFT MAIN STAGE SECURITY PROCEDURES

Security screening for the Draft Main Stage, ACME and Hard Rock Café on 1st and Broadway will be significantly heightened for 2019 NFL Draft. All items carried by fans will be carefully inspected and potentially not permitted to the Draft Main Stage.

Permissible Bags: (visit nfl.com/allclear for more details)

- Bags that are clear plastic, vinyl or PVC and do not exceed 12" x 6" x 12"
- One-gallon clear plastic freezer bag
- Clutch bags smaller than 4.5" x 6.5", with/without a handle or strap
- An exception will be made for medically necessary items after thorough inspection at Entry C designated for this purpose

The following list is not all-inclusive. All items are subject to security discretion:

| - Chairs, stools or other seating devices | - Tripods |
| - Containers of any type (aerosol cans, coolers of any size, bottles) | - Umbrella |
| - Coolers | - Firearms, weapons, knives and explosives |
| - Computer bags | - Whistles |
| - Fanny Packs | |
| - Fireworks, pyrotechnics of any kind | |

Any other item deemed potentially dangerous or unsafe by event security will not be permitted.

Note: Prohibited items and items determined to not be appropriate for entry into the secure perimeter will be the responsibility of the fan and cannot be accepted or checked by the NFL or the Nashville Police Department.

Cameras and Binoculars – Small cameras and binoculars will be allowed. No spectator cameras with lenses more than six inches (6") long will be permitted. Camcorders are not allowed. Binocular cases and camera bags are not permitted.
